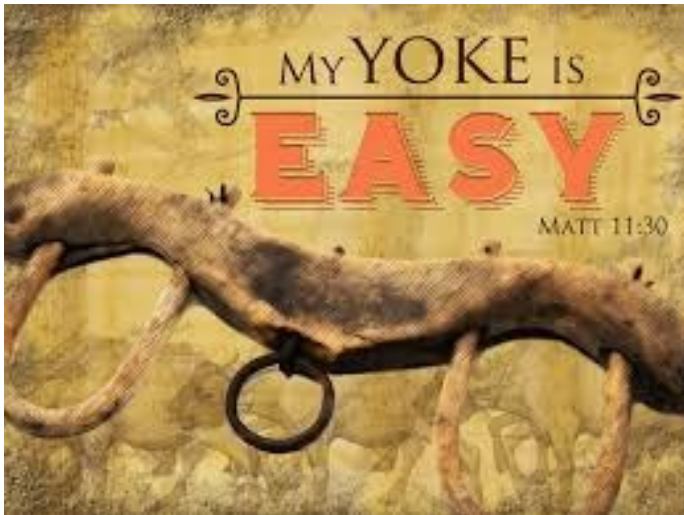

**Sunday Sing:** alternate Sundays at 9.30 a.m., taking a break in June and July.

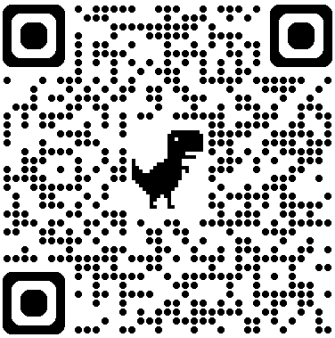
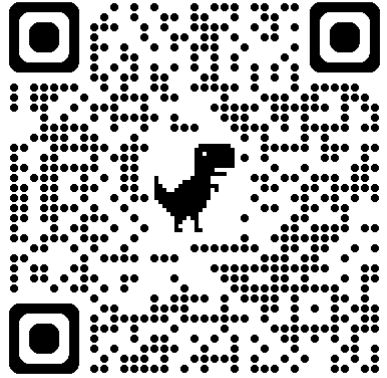
**Ladies@10:** alternate Wednesday mornings, taking a break till September.
