Men's Prayer Breakfast: Saturdays 25 July and 8 and 22 August, 8.00-9.00 a.m. in the Church Hall.

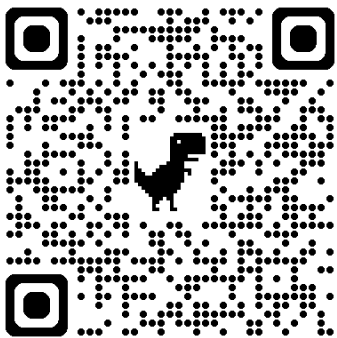
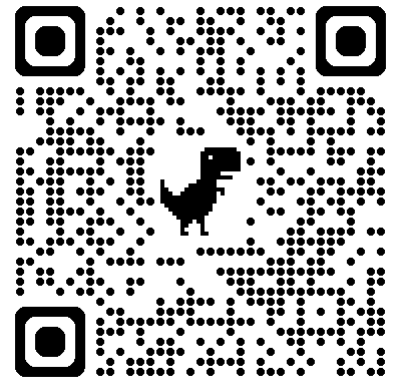
Sunday Sing: alternate Sundays at 9.30 a.m., taking a break in June and July.
